OUTSTANDING CHARACTER AWARD FOR TEENAGERS

PURPOSE:

To recognize and show appreciation for teenagers who have contributed significantly to the welfare of a family or community member and to inspire other teens to demonstrate exemplary behavior toward families and neighbors.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Who** Teenagers aged 13 to 19 who have demonstrated exemplary behavior during the past year, as evidenced by meeting the criteria described below.
- Time Period** April 2021 through March 2022.
- Residence** Has resided in an area served by the McLean Citizens Association ([MCA Area Map](#)) to include:
- McLean ZIP codes 22101 or 22102, **OR**
 - Falls Church ZIP codes 22043 or 22046 located south of Route 7, not to include Falls Church City, **OR**
 - Neighborhoods within the Great Falls 22066 or Vienna 22182 ZIP codes which feed into McLean or Langley High School.

CRITERIA:

The teenager is eligible for an award based on one or two activities that have been performed in the Greater Washington D.C. metropolitan area, and which together:

- Occurred on a continuing basis at least 10 times and for not less than 30 hours.
- Are initiated by the teenager, and not initiated by someone else.
- Are voluntary in nature.
- Provide no financial compensation.
- Do not include participation in a performing arts activity.
- Do not involve a religious affiliation.
- Are not school-related.
- Do not constitute an unpaid internship.
- Must contribute significantly to the welfare of a family or community member.

In addition, the teenager:

- Must be present, unless other arrangements have been made with the Committee, to receive the award on McLean Day, Saturday, May 21, 2022 at 3 PM.
- Must not have been previously recognized or been given credit for these activities by the MCA or any other organization (such as school, church group, Rotary, Girl or Boy Scouts, National Honor Society, Key or Keyettes Club).
- Must have demonstrated one or more of the following values: caring, trustworthiness, responsibility, fairness, respect, citizenship.
- Must not have exhibited significant negative behavior (e.g., speeding tickets, vandalism during past year).

PROCEDURE:

1. Complete the application, which includes written information from two nominators. **BOTH** nominators must be 21 years of age or older; only one may be a family member, relative, or person living with the teenager. All forms must be filled in completely with separate narrative justifications. If the nominee is part of a group, the justification must be specific to the role of the nominee.
